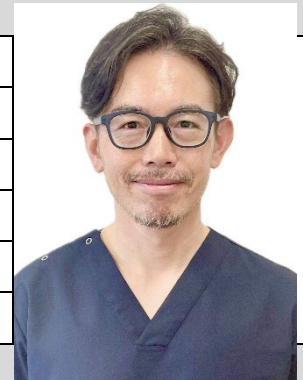

Curriculum Vitae

Takafumi Hosokawa, MD, PhD, is an orthopedic surgeon specializing in hand and wrist surgery at Kiryu Orthopaedic Surgery Hospital in Japan. His clinical and research interests include distal radius fractures, volar locking plate fixation, carpal alignment, and postoperative outcomes in hand surgery. He was selected as a KSSH-JSSH Traveling Fellow in 2022. He has also delivered presentations at the 2022 Annual International Meeting of the Korean Society for Surgery of the Hand, on radiographic assessments and short-term outcomes after conservative treatment of distal radius fractures in geriatric patients, and at the Asia Pacific Orthopaedic Association Hand and Upper Limb Society Meeting 2023 in Korea, on the flexor carpi radialis brevis and technical considerations in distal radius fracture surgery. His current work focuses on optimizing surgical strategies for complex distal radius fractures, particularly fractures involving the volar rim.
