Dr. Cheng-Hung Lin is Professor and Chair of the Department of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital in Taipei, Taiwan. He is a leading expert in reconstructive microsurgery with specialized focus on extremity reconstruction.

In addition to his work in traditional microsurgery, Dr. Lin has pioneered novel vascularized composite allotransplantation models for transplantation research. He has authored over 150 peer-reviewed publications and has received multiple prestigious awards for his contributions to transplantation science and reconstructive microsurgery.

As Director of Clinical Trials for Hand and Upper Extremity Allotransplantation at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital, Dr. Lin led the surgical teams responsible for Taiwan's first bilateral forearm transplantation in 2017 and the nation's first arm transplantation in 2018. Most recently, in late 2025, he successfully performed the third upper extremity transplantation for a high-level amputee.

Currently serving as President of the Taiwan Society for Reconstructive Microsurgery, Dr. Lin continues to lead advancements in the field through clinical excellence, scientific innovation, and the integration of cutting-edge technologies, including artificial intelligence, to optimize functional outcomes in extremity reconstruction.
